Rules & Information

- Eligibility: Run for the Ribbons Horse Show Series at Cedar Lock Farm LLC is open to all thoroughbreds (no stallions ridden by minors) who are tattooed, registered with Jockey Club, or identifiable. If you are unsure of your horse's tattoo # or can't locate Jockey Club papers, you must be able to provide the following information to secretary.
 - The name of The Jockey Club registered sire and dam of your thoroughbred, or
 - Name of private breeder through which you obtained you horse.

Once verification is established, show secretary will determine whether or not your horse is eligible to participate. If you have Jockey Club papers, or a copy thereof, please bring with you to the show!

- ASTM approved helmets must be worn and fastened at all times when mounted. Proper attire required for hunter divisions; polo shirt acceptable for jumping classes. Any safety equipment is allowed and not penalized.
- All horses coming onto show grounds must present a current negative Coggins (within 12 months)
- Office hours will be 1:00pm-6pm Friday, 7am- end of show Saturday
- Ribbons: 6 ribbons awarded in all classes; prize for winner with 4 or more riders in class. Champion & Reserve Champion ribbons awarded along with prizes for Champion. In all Classics 10 ribbons will be awarded along with cash prize.
- Series Points: 1st=6 pts., 2nd=5 pts., 3rd=4 pts., 4th=3 pts., 5th=2 pts., 6th=1 pt. / Day End Division Champion = 10 pts., Day End Division Reserve Champion = 6 pts.
- Schooling: Friday 1pm-dark. Saturday ring is open for schooling until 7:45am. Schooling is \$5 per horse if showing, \$20 open schooling fee
- Entries: Early entries are appreciated! \$5 off per entry for early entries. Early entries end the Thursday before show.

- **Grounds/Office Fee:** \$15 per horse
- Stall Reservations: We have a very limited number of stalls for Friday & Saturday night. \$60 2 nights; \$30 for one night (we supply bedding). Available from 12 noon on Friday 9 am Sunday after show. Stalls should be requested with your entry and are non-refundable; due to limited # available they will be assigned as they come in and you will be notified immediately when we are full.
- Payment: An open check is needed for the show office to cover your entries before your number can be picked up.
 All checks should be made out to Run for the Ribbons Inc.

It is the responsibility of each exhibitor or agent to settle his/her account within one hour after the end of the show. Failure to do so will give Horse Show Secretary Authority to fill in the correct amount owed to the horse show. All checks returned for non-payment will be charged a \$50 handling fee and must be replaced by a certified check or money order. Credit cards are not accepted.

- Dogs: Are permitted on the grounds but must be leashed at all times. No dogs are allowed at any time in the show ring or schooling area whether leashed or unleashed.
- Run for the Ribbons Inc. & Cedar Lock Farm LLC and its management will not be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it will be a condition of the entry that each exhibitor or owner shall hold Run for the Ribbons Inc. Or Cedar Lock Farm LLC and its management harmless for any loss or accident to his or her horse(s) or equipment that may occur from sickness, fire, or otherwise. Run for the Ribbons Inc. & Cedar Lock Farm LLC will not be responsible for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed or stolen, and will not be responsible for injury sustained in any way by exhibitors, spectators, employees or other involved parties. Horse Show Management reserves the right to: (1) Vary or add to the names of those officials who have been invited to participate; (2)Add, combine, or cancel any class; (3)Refuse any or all entries, return any money paid for stalls or entry fee without explanation or recourse to the Show for liability or compensation. Run for the Ribbons Inc. & Cedar Lock Farm LLC shall be under absolute control of the management. Only qualified persons shall be allowed in the ring during judging. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judge or officials by the owner, rider, trainer, or groom will disqualify horse or rider, and the owner shall forfeit all fees and payments. Judge's decision is final.
- Exhibitors are required to give the necessary personal attention to and maintain control of their animals and equipment at all times. When animals are moved about, they shall be constantly attended. Each exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any loss or damage done to, occasioned by, or arising from any animal or vehicle owned or exhibited by the exhibitor and shall indemnify the show and hold it harmless from any loss, cost or expense caused. The exhibitor assumes all risk of loss, injury, or damage of every kind and nature, however, caused, to the property belonging to him and any of his employees. Exhibitors are urged to keep attendants at their exhibit at all times and to carry insurance for their protection against any losses that might be incurred and to protect themselves from risks assumed under this clause.
- It is required that all exhibitors must read & sign waiver (page and return to office before back number will be issued. (page 3)

Proof of negative Coggins Required

I AGREE, to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of Run for the Ribbons Inc., Cedar Lock Farm LLC or the Competition.



Hunter Class Specifications

Over Fences – To be shown over a course of at least 6 jumps at their respective heights. A combination may not be used except in Classics. To be judged on manners, way of going, pace and in accordance with specifications for each division as stated in their descriptions.

Under Saddle- To be shown at the walk, trot and canter both directions of the ring. Shall be judged on movement, manners and way of going. Martingales are not permitted.

Pleasure Class Specifications

Walk/Trot Pleasure- To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk and trot. To be judged on manners, suitability of horse to rider and performance.

Pleasure- To be shown at a walk, trot and canter, both ways of the ring, with light rein, but still maintaining contact with horse's mouth.

Division Descriptions

Ring 1 (only thoroughbreds only)

Leadline - \$10

1) Open to riders 8 years of age or under. To be shown collectively at the walk, and individually at the trot or jog. To be judged with emphasis on equitation; also suitability and manners of mount to be considered. Leader to be on foot and must be over 14 years of age. Appropriate dress required for rider, but leader need not be in riding attire but must be neatly and appropriately dressed.

TB Walk/Trot - \$15/class or \$40 division

64,65,66,66b & 67) Rider w/t/c on the flat , canter simple verticals at 2'3". No cross entry of 2'. Simple changes acceptable. All classes count as 1 point.
